- I hereby declare that I have had the opportunity to read and that I understand the National Sporting Code of the ACU, the ACU Standing Regulations as have or may be issued for the event and agree to be bound by them.
- I further declare that I am physically and mentally fit to take part in the event and am competent to do so.
- I confirm that I understand the nature and type of event and the risks inherent with the sport and agree to accept the same notwithstanding that such risks may involve negligence on the part of the organisers/officials.
- I further declare that I shall not seek to claim against the SACU Ltd, the organisers nor their officials, the landowners, the promoter or other bodies or individuals connected with the event in respect of any damage to my property howsoever caused, and whether by the negligence or breach of statutory duty of the said bodies and persons and agree that any injury report will be able to be shared between the medical staff and the club for insurance purposes.
- I understand and agree that I am required to register my arrival by signing on at the designated area not less than 30 minutes prior to commencement of said competitor's practice or first competition, whichever comes first.
- To comply with GDPR I herewith give SCRMC LTD permission to store my information.
- I confirm that I am not currently suspended from SACU/ACU permitted competition or on the ACU/SACU Stop list as a result of incurring a concussion injury. I shall notify the club should I incur such a suspension or concussion injury between now and the race event.
- I further agree that the machine which I enter and compete on shall be suitable for its purpose and that it will comply with the regulations in respect thereof and is described above. I confirm that any machine I will use will be safe and suitable for the duration of the event. Furthermore the condition of the machine I enter will be my sole responsibility.

I understand that by taking part in this event I am exposed to a risk of death, becoming permanently disabled or suffering some other serious injury and I acknowledge that even in the event that negligence on the part of SACU, the promoter, the organising club, the venue owner, or any individual carrying out duties on their behalf were to do a contributory cause of any serious injury I may suffer, the dominant cause of any serious injury will always be my voluntary decision to take part in a high risk activity. I have read the above, and acknowledge that my participation in motor sport is entirely at my own risk.

### GENERAL RULES OF MEETING

- The meeting is held under the ACU National Sporting Code and the Standing Regulations of the ACU and these Supplementary Regulations.
- **All entry forms must be completed in full and sent with payment & appropriate forms as necessary.**
- **Signing-on, checking of body armour and helmets will take place between 09:15am and 10.00 am**
- Practice will be in 2 groups, all pre-75 machines followed by all 78 to 84's,
- Bikes may be ridden at walking pace only along riding lane to start/finish any rider flaunting the above rule will be banned from the next meeting.
- Riders must hold a current Off Road Competition License issued by the SACU, ACU, IOPD, MCF, AMCA and any foreign FIM affiliated federation with start permission. One Event Licenses will be available to download at [www.classicscrambles.com](http://www.classicscrambles.com)
- **IOPD, AMCA & MCF Licence holders are required to pay an insurance supplement of £3 and complete a SACU Medical Declaration Form available to download at <http://classicscrambles.com/forms/>**
- There will be three races in each class.
- All riders MUST have a 2kg dry powder fire extinguisher available.
- All Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
- SCRMC LTD retains the right to alter or amend the programme at its discretion.
- **ILLEGAL RIDING AT MEETINGS** - Anyone riding on the track out-with races or misbehaving in the pits will face a one meeting ban.
- **Riders MUST notify the club of any recent [within the last 23 days] concussion injury and will produce a doctor's note to state I am able to compete in the event. The doctor's note to state "The rider is no longer suffering the consequences of concussion"**

### CLOTHING

- All riders must wear helmet. Helmets must have the current ACU approved stamp.
- All riders must wear gloves, knee length protective boots.
- **It is compulsory riders wear a minimum, back and chest protectors, incorporated within the suit or worn.**
- It is advised that all riders should wear a body belt/kidney protector
- Goggles or visor of a non-splinterable type must be worn at the commencement of each race. **Goggles with 'tear offs' are NOT allowed, any rider caught using tear offs will be disciplined.**
- Spectacles, if worn must be non-splinterable.
- **Helmet and body cameras are not permitted.**

**Eligibility complaints must be submitted in writing to the SCRMC LTD scrambles committee.** Along with a fee of £50.00

### RIDING NUMBERS

- Pre 60 Blue plates with White numbers
- Pre 68 up to 350cc White plates with Black numbers
- Pre 68 over 350cc Black plates with White numbers
- Pre 75 up to 350cc Green plates with White numbers
- Pre 75 over 350cc Yellow plates with Black numbers
- Pre 77 White plates with Black numbers
- Pre 84 up to 250cc Green plates with White numbers
- Pre 84 over 250cc Green plates with Black numbers
- Pre 89 125cc Black plates with White numbers

**All riding numbers must be clearly displayed**
