ENTRY DECLARATION: I the undersigned apply to enter the event described above and in consideration thereof: -

- I declare that I have had the opportunity to read, and that I understand the National Sporting Code of the ACU, the ACU Standing Regulations, such Supplementary Regulations as have or may be issued for the event, and agree to be bound by them.
- I declare that I am physically and mentally fit to take part in the event and I am competent to do so. I confirm that I understand the nature and type of event I am entering and its inherent risks and agree to accept the same notwithstanding that such risks may involve negligence on the part of the organisers or officials.
- I confirm that I am not currently suspended from ACU permitted competition or on the ACU Stop List as a result of incurring a Concussion injury.
- I accept that insurance arranged on my behalf by the organisers of events that I may enter specifically excludes liability between the participants. I understand that this form may be used in litigation as evidence that any serious injury will be principally the result of my voluntary decision to engage in a high risk activity.
- I consent to details of any injuries I may suffer at this event being passed between all medical services and the Clerk of the Course.
- I have read and understood **The Auto Cycle Union Ltd Data Protection Policy** and I consent to the collection and retention of my personal information by the ACU.
- I confirm that the machine(s) as described below which I shall participate on shall be suitable and proper for the purpose. I confirm that I am eligible to compete on the machines for which I have entered.
- I confirm that if any part of the event takes place on a public highway, the machine(s) described below shall be insured as required by the Road Traffic Acts, or equivalent legislation, and that they will comply with the regulations in respect thereof.
- I accept responsibility for any items borrowed from the Organiser during the course of the event. These items include but are not restricted to (safety clothing, transponders, accessories). I understand that I am liable for the cost or replacement of any items lost or not returned and non-payment or non-replacement of items borrowed may affect my entry into subsequent events.
- I confirm that I have not been refused an ACU Licence, nor had an ACU Licence suspended, nor have I been excluded from any ACU competition.
- I declare that should I contract coronavirus in a ten day period prior to the event taking place, I will not travel to or participate/officiate at the event and will follow Gov.UK guidance/advice as appropriate.

I understand and accept that as the Supplementary Regulations state the Insurance cover for this event is "Basic" (Limited liability of £10m) and

Medical malpractice insurance included (limited liability of £5m) is included. There is NO personal accident insurance for Competitors.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF THE RISKS OF MOTORSPORT: I understand that by taking part in this event I am exposed to a risk of death, becoming permanently disabled or suffering some other serious injury and I acknowledge that even in the event that negligence on the part of the ACU, any event organiser, any circuit owner, the promoter, the organising club, the venue owner, or any individual carrying out duties on their behalf were to be a contributory cause of any serious injury I may suffer, the dominant cause of any serious injury will always be my voluntary decision to take part in a high risk activity.

GENERAL RULES OF MEETING

- The meeting is held under the ACU National Sporting Code and the Standing Regulations of the ACU and these Supplementary Regulations.
- **All entry forms must be completed in full and sent with payment & appropriate forms as necessary.**
- **Signing-on, checking of body armour and helmets will take place between 09:15am and 10.00 am**
- Practice will be in 2 groups, all pre-75 machines followed by all 78 to 84's,
- Bikes may be ridden at walking pace only along riding lane to start/finish any rider flaunting the above rule will be banned from the next meeting.
- Riders must hold a current Off Road Competition License issued by the SACU, ACU,
- **IOPD, AMCA & MCF Licence holders are required to purchase a ACU one event licence. Which will be completed at sign on.**
- There will be three races in each class.
- All riders MUST have a 2kg dry powder fire extinguisher available.
- All Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
- SCRMC LTD retains the right to alter or amend the programme at its discretion.
- ILLEGAL RIDING AT MEETINGS - Anyone riding on the track out-with races or misbehaving in the pits will face a one meeting ban.
- **Riders MUST notify the club of any recent [within the last 23 days] concussion injury and will produce a doctor's note to state I am able to compete in the event. The doctor's note to state "The rider is no longer suffering the consequences of concussion"**

CLOTHING

- All riders must wear helmet. Helmets must have the current ACU approved stamp.
- All riders must wear gloves, knee length protective boots.
- **It is compulsory riders wear a minimum, back and chest protectors, incorporated within the suit or worn.**
- It is advised that all riders should wear a body belt/kidney protector
- Goggles or visor of a non-splinterable type must be worn at the commencement of each race. **Goggles with 'tear offs' are NOT allowed, any rider caught using tear offs will be disciplined.**
- Spectacles, if worn must be non-splinterable.
- **Helmet and body cameras are not permitted.**

Eligibility complaints must be submitted in writing to the SCRMC LTD Scrambles committee. Along with a fee of £50.00

RIDING NUMBERS

- Pre 60 Blue plates with White numbers
- Pre 68 up to 350cc White plates with Black numbers
- Pre 68 over 350cc Black plates with White numbers
- Pre 75 up to 350cc Green plates with White numbers
- Pre 75 over 350cc Yellow plates with Black numbers
- Pre 77 White plates with Black numbers
- Pre 84 up to 250cc Green plates with White numbers
- Pre 84 over 250cc Green plates with Black numbers
- Pre 89 125cc Black plates with White numbers
