### GENERAL RULES OF MEETING

- The meeting is held under the ACU National Sporting Code and the Standing Regulations of the ACU and these Supplementary Regulations.
- **All entry forms must be completed in full and sent with payment & appropriate forms as necessary.**
- Signing-on and scrutineering of machines, clothing and helmets will take place between 09:00am and 10.00 am
- Practice will be in 2 groups, all pre-75 machines followed by all 78 to 84's,
- Bikes may be ridden at walking pace only along riding lane to start/finish any rider flaunting the above rule will be banned from the next meeting.
- Riders must hold a current Off Road Competition License issued by the SACU, ACU, IOPD, MCF, AMCA and any foreign FIM affiliated federation with start permission. One Event Licenses will be available to download at [www.classicscrambles.com](http://www.classicscrambles.com)
- **IOPD, AMCA & MCF Licence holders are required to pay an insurance supplement of £3 and complete a SACU Medical Declaration Form (available to download at [www.classicscrambles.com](http://www.classicscrambles.com))**
- There will be three races in each class.
- All riders MUST have a 2kg dry powder fire extinguisher available.
- All Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
- SCRMC retains the right to alter or amend the programme at its discretion.
- **ILLEGAL RIDING AT MEETINGS** - Anyone riding on the track out-with races or misbehaving in the pits will face a one meeting ban.
- **Riders MUST notify the club of any recent [within the last 23 days] concussion injury and will produce a doctor's note to state I am able to compete in the event. The doctor's note to state "The rider is no longer suffering the consequences of concussion"**

### CLOTHING

- Helmets must have the current ACU approved stamp.
- All riders must wear helmet, gloves, knee length protective boots and **it is compulsory that riders wear as a minimum, back and chest protectors. Incorporated within the suit or worn separately.** It is advised that all riders should wear a body belt/kidney protector
- Goggles or visor of a non-splinterable type must be worn at the commencement of each race. **Goggles with 'tear offs' are NOT allowed, any rider caught using tear offs will be disciplined.**
- Spectacles, if worn, must be non-splinterable.

### MACHINE ELIGIBILITY (subject to General Eligibility)

- Pre '60 Any machine manufactured before 31st December 1960
- Pre '68 Any machine manufactured before 31st December 1968
- Pre '75 Any machine manufactured before 31st December 1975
- Pre '77 Any machine manufactured before 31st December 1977
- Pre '84 Any machine manufactured before 31st December 1984

**Eligibility complaints must be submitted in writing to the Committee. Any rider blatantly altering machines after scrutineering will be excluded from the meeting.**

### RIDING NUMBERS

- Pre '60 Blue plates with White numbers
- Pre '68 up to 350cc White plates with Black numbers
- Pre '68 over 350cc Black plates with White numbers
- Pre '75 up to 350cc Green plates with White numbers
- Pre '75 over 350cc Yellow plates with Black numbers
- Pre '77 White plates with Black numbers
- Pre '84 Green plates with Black numbers

**All riding numbers must be clearly displayed (as per Standing Regulations.)**

### GENERAL ELIGIBILITY – Apply to all classes.

- All machines must be air-cooled.
- All machines must have front and rear drum brakes.
- All machines must be fitted with engine cut-out button.
- Methanol fuel may be used in all Pre 68 machines only.
- Monobloc or older type carburettors may be replaced with concentric carbs.
- Machines presented for use at the event **MUST** be in race worthy condition.
- **The Chief Technician's decision will be final.**
- Any other modifications shall be decided by the Committee and their decision is final.

### SUSPENSION CRITERIA

- Rear shock absorbers may be of a modern type but must be dimensionally the same as the original parts and must not be fitted in such a way as to give greater travel at the rear wheel.
- Pre68 Machines must have fork travel maximum of 6.5 inches. Rear wheel spindle movement maximum of 4 inches. The maximum rear suspension unit distance between mounting holes centre must be 13 inches.
- Pre75 Machines must have period forks only; suspension travel is unspecified and rear wheel spindle movement 7.5 inches.
- The onus is on the rider to demonstrate suspension eligibility if requested.
